Selling of the Chametz

Mechirat Chametz 5786

The Bible instructs that in observing Pesach, all leaven must be removed from one's home. Life conditions make it impossible to literally fulfill this Biblical edict, and rabbinic authorities instituted a legal fiction: one transfers his chametz to the rabbi, who in turn sells it to a non-Jew. It is traditional at Pesach-time to give Ma'ot Chitim - tzedakah to help feed the hungry.
